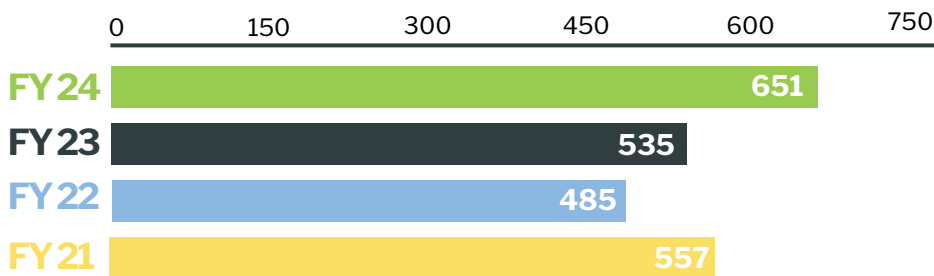
Thank you for continuing to grow with us as we honor the memories, experiences, and feelings of those who seek care at The Sharing Place. It means the world to us.

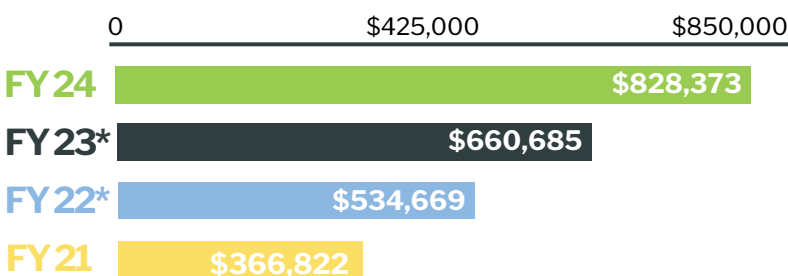
